*The park includes a children's playground, a beautiful gazebo, and a Veteran's Memorial consisting of a wall with over 3,000 names of Moniteau County veterans who have served or are currently serving in the United States military along with various statues. The plaque shown of the memorial wall. During the dedication program, the white table will be set up as a symbol of the sacrifice of our veterans. Participating will be the Burger family, the Bolinger family, the Whiteman AFB Color Guard, members of the VFW and the American Legion, the Masonic Lodge, the California Heroes Outreach Program, the California the California Community Band, and the California Choir, and the members of the Moniteau County 4-H.*



*Ribbon cutting for the Park will be at 1:00PM followed by the unveiling of the Wall, presentation of the Colors by the Color Guard, singing of the National Anthem, the Pledge of Allegiance, a Prayer, bagpipe playing of Amazing Grace, the Laying of Wreath and bell ringing, a thank you, Taps, Volley salute and a flyover.
